Introduction

Managing bookmarks or favorites websites is important for today's teachers! Five or six sites are easy to remember, but hundreds and thousands of sites are impossible to remember.

Moreover, del.icio.us allows you to access your bookmarks from **any computer**. If you want, you can **share** your bookmarks with your friends or students.

Bookmarks can be **tagged** into categories, making it easier to organize your bookmarks.

Curious about the name?

del.icio.us plays with a concept called **domains** and **sub domains**. The actual site is icio.us. Then, a subdomain is added, del. Pretty geeky, huh?

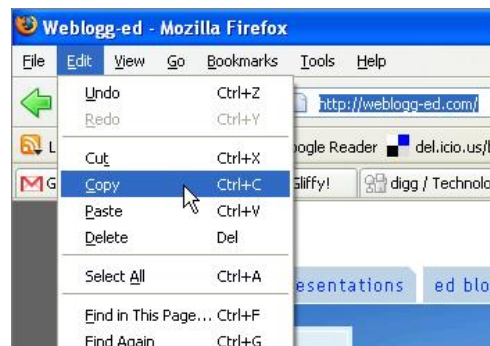
HOWTO:

1) Register with del.icio.us by clicking on the register link.

2) Once registered, find a site you like, and copy the URL. We copy a URL by highlighting it, and then clicking on **file** and **edit**.



3) Click on the **post** link, and **paste** the URL into the link box. Fill out the box.



4) Note the tags section. Simply fill out as much as you can, and click save!
